Notice of Intent Special District Candidate

Florida Statutes, Section 99.061(3), provides all special district candidates shall qualify by paying a filing fee of \$25.00 or by the petition process pursuant to Florida Statute 99.095. Notwithstanding Florida Statute 106.021, a special district candidate who does not collect contributions and whose only expense is the filing fee or signature verification fee is not required to appoint a campaign treasurer or designate a primary campaign depository.

In the event that a special district candidate decides to accept contributions and/or make expenditures, they must file a DS-DE 9, Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository, with the Supervisor of Elections. A DS-DE 84 Statement of Candidate must also be filed within 10 days after the Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository. These forms are available to all candidates through the Supervisor of Elections office or can be found on the Division of Elections website.
